Creating a panel in Adobe Configurator

What is Adobe Configurator?

- It's a 'box of Legos" for Photoshop.
- Drag and drop tools, menu items, actions, scripts, and prefab widgets (video, text, search, etc.).
- Don't just remix existing UI elements: contextual them in meaningful ways.

	 In Photoshop CS4, load your new panel from the Window->Extensions menu. (Restart Photoshop after exporting your panel for the first time.)

Creating Your First Panel

BeginnerScripts:

Delete all Channels

• Use the DOM to unlock new functionality.

Delete all Channels with 1 Undo

• Use suspendHistory to improve the user experience.

Super-Flatten

• Create a multi-step workflow for production: Flatten the file, remove channels and paths.

Close All Docs Without Saving

• Use a while loop to process all open documents.

Stamp Visible

• Use the scripting listener to get at hard to find commands.

Creating Your Second Panel

PanosFX:

Brand a Panel

- Add an image using relative paths.
- Add collapsed panel icons.

Understand the Configurator export process

Run and install an action

• Understand error handling and load an action via a ExtendScript.

Add a button that launches a URL

• Reference and execute an external file using the file.execute method in ExtendScript

Create an installer using the MXI file and Extension Manager CS4

How is Scripting different from Actions?

• Actions are easy to use. You hit record, do your steps, hit stop and play back.

• Actions while powerful enough for most users, are basically "monkey see, monkey do."



With Scripting you can:

Get information from Photoshop:

- Intelligent renaming of files
- Perform Conditional Actions

Process multiple Images:

- Process folders of images.
- Process all open documents.
- Create documents from scratch



With Scripting you can:

Process multiple parts of documents:

- Layers
- Comps
- Channels

<u>Create text files with information from processed images:</u>

- .csv/spreadsheets
- .xml & .html
- .js/javascript



With Scripting you can:

Manipulate the file system:

- Create new folders.
- Open, save, copy, move, and load files.

Design User Interfaces:

• Create an easy to use interface for non-scripters.



Photoshop supports 3 scripting languages:

- AppleScript
- VB Script
- JavaScript

• AppleScript and VB Script are platform specific scripting languages.



Focus on JavaScript:

- JavaScript is NOT Java.
- JavaScript is not compiled.
- Requires only only a text editor to create.
- Like HTML, it's easy to start with templates, and/or learn from someone else's code.

Where do you begin scripting: Learn Script Grammar

- You don't need to write the whole story
- Only need to know a few things about grammar:
- Verbs and Nouns





Where do you begin scripting: Learn Script Grammar

- You don't need to write an entire script
- Nouns = Documents, Layers and Channels
- Verbs = Methods and Functions





Where do you begin scripting: Recipes

- 1 cup boiling water1 pkg. Strawberry JELL-O
- 2 cups mixed berries
- 1 pkg. (8 oz.) PHILADELPHIA Cream Cheese
- 1-1/4 cups cold milk
- 1 pkg. Vanilla JELL-O Instant Pudding
- 1 tub (8 oz.) COOL WHIP Topping, thawed1 pkg. (12 oz.) pound cake, cubed





Where do you begin scripting: Reuse complex ingredients

Ingredients: sugar, gelatin, adipic acid (for tartness), less than 2% of artificial flavor, disodium phosphate and sodium citrate (to control acidity), fumaric acid (for tartness), and the colorant red 40.
